### Target Server Capacity

The target server needs adequate capacity to run the applications you are migrating: the same as or greater storage capacity and compute resources than the source server:

- equal or greater number of CPU cores
- equal or greater available memory (RAM)
- equal or greater available disk space; if you will be Dissolving, twice the available disk space
- same number of disks, each with equal or greater size and the same drive letter as on the source server

The drive on the target server where the container will be created (by default, C:\appliances) needs enough space to contain the entire application, meaning the sum total of all drives used by the application.

### Incompatible 3rd-Party Apps

Microsoft Exchange  
Microsoft Active Directory services  
Any application that embeds Internet Explorer  
Any application that includes kernel drivers  
Any 16-bit application
